

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DORCHESTER ROAD, SYDLING ST NICHOLAS

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along DORCHESTER ROAD, SYDLING ST NICHOLAS outside Lampert's Farm, a distance of approximately 85 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 11 September 2023 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 08 October 2023.

**This Order will enable Amberon Ltd, to provide safe working area for scaffolding and building works.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Sydling Road - A37 - C19
