Report from Blundeston Charity Trustees - May 2020

Blundeston Charity Trust is a Trust that is run for the benefit of the poor and needy residents of Blundeston. It receives income from the rental of a property at 2 The Hedgerows, various pieces of land in the village, marshes and shooting rights.

This year's total income amounted to £13,418.94 with expenditure of £14,440.92 resulting in excess expenditure over income of £1,021.98. The Blundeston Charity liquid assets at 31st March 2020 are recorded at £105,045.96. £52,407.87 in COIF Investment Units, £36,375.82 in COIF Deposit Account and £16,262.27 held at HSBC.

At Christmas 2020, 84 households in Blundeston received a gift of £70 for a single person, £120 for a couple. Nine Students living away from home received a grants of £300 each. Medical assistance grants of £200.00 and Student grants of £600 were also given.

The trustees are happy to consider any application for funds, and each will be reviewed on its merit.
