Generic Email and New Website start date – The clerk thanked all the councillors for setting up there new email addresses and it was agreed that the new website would go live by the first December.

Roundabout in playpark-Cllr K Robinson has agreed to fund £1500 for the repairs to the roundabout the Councillors thanked Keith for this kind offer and agreed to take the roundabout to BFS as soon as possible.

Beacon on Millennium Green-The beacon will be taken to Buckingham Blast to get the work carried out as soon as possible.

It was mentioned about the Hedges from the church that some mums from the school had complained that they are hanging over the path but due to the theft of all the equipment from the church shed it has delayed them being cut back this will be done as soon as possible.
