2022 10/121	<b>Minutes of the meetings held on Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> July 2022.</b> It was RESOLVED to adopt the Minutes of the meetings above, previously circulated and taken as read. Proposed S. McNair-Scott, seconded W. Drayson and agreed unanimously.	
2022 10/122	<b>Planning Applications for consultation:</b> Application: PA22/07780 Location: Land NW of Beechwood, Lesnewth. Boscastle. Proposal: Proposed dwelling and garage. The revised design of this dwelling was considered to be more in keeping with other properties in this hamlet, but much concern was expressed over the sewerage and water supply aspects of the proposed build. It was agreed that the Clerk should speak with the Planning Officer (Helen Trebilcock) prior to this meeting submitting any comments.	Clerk.
2022 10/123	<b>Finance:</b> A balance of £2598.42, at 25.10.22 was noted. It was agreed to pay £20 to S. McNair-Scott for removal of the old noticeboard, and £195.60 to the Clerk for the purchase of a new (bound) Minute book, thereafter leaving a balance of £2382.82. S. McNair-Scott proposed acceptance of these figures, seconded by W. Drayson and agreed unanimously. It was agreed that a meeting be held on Wednesday, 30 <sup>th</sup> November to consider the precept for 2023-2024.	
2022 10/124	<b>Purchase of Defibrillator for Lesnewth:</b> 'Primary Care Suppliers' had quoted £1614 for a fully automated AED, outdoor package. It was agreed the Clerk should seek a quote from The Heartbeat Trust to see if a more favourable price could be achieved.	
2022 10/125	<b>"Coffin Stile":</b> No update on progress of this matter at this time. Left 'on the table' for next meeting.

Fallen leaves and wet weather made the road extremely dangerous for vehicles. Also better signage is needed at the junction, grid reference SX13609 90189 (Penpol turn) Clerk to contact Highways Inspector, Oliver Jones.</p> <p><b>Matters of Public Interest / Date of next meeting:</b> 30<sup>th</sup> November 2022.</p> <p>It was noted that Sewerage arrangements introduced at The Old Posting House, Trewoold. PL35 0BW were questionable and the Environment Agency should be asked to investigate the current arrangement for disposal of effluent.</p> <p>Simon McNair- Scott wished his thanks be noted to the Hayne brothers and Julian Findlay for their assistance in clearing, and cutting back, in the churchyard over the summer.</p> <p>It was further noted that the 'grave by grave' survey within St Michael's churchyard had now been completed.</p> <p>It was to be hoped that high speed broadband would soon come to Lesnewth.</p> <p>Finally, it was noted that Celia Langley no longer felt able to sell poppies on behalf of The Royal British Legion and a volunteer was sought to take responsibility for the collection throughout the parish. Justin Ruscombe-King kindly offered to take on this task, for which he was thanked.</p> <p>There being no further business, the meeting closed at 8.20pm.</p>
