

LESNEWTH PARISH MEETING
Meeting held in Lesnewth Church
24th May 2023

23/5/152 Persons Present: S. McNair-Scott, C. Hayne, C. Cllr. B. Jordan.

23/5/153 Apologies: F. Carlyon, M. Linnington.

23/5/154 Cllr. B. Jordan: Mention was made of the new car parking charges instituted by Cornwall Council. All had been put into 'bands' thus meaning many had gone up in price. Cornwall Council had set aside £52K for Highway maintenance and Improvements within this Community Area Partnership, this sum to cover maintenance and improvement to 2025.

23/5/155 Minutes of the Meeting held on 26th April 2023: S. McNair-Scott proposed Approval of these Minutes, seconded by C. Hayne and agreed.

23/5/156 Matters Arising: C. Hayne questioned certain wording in a future precept calculation, sent by the Clerk, to all residents of Lesnewth as he felt the wording suggested that all residents were 'well off'. A claim he disputed.

23/5/157 Planning Applications: None received at this time.

23/5/158 Planning Decisions Received: None at this time.

23/5/159 Finance Report: It was noted that the balance in the bank stood at £869.10. There were two debts outstanding. £24.48 Atlantic Signs and £601.13 JWE Electrical Ltd. These debts had been covered by the Clerk's personal account whilst further funds are awaited. It was noted that S. McNair-Scott had, as yet, received no financial help from this Meeting towards his, and others, costs incurred for upkeep of the churchyard.

23/5/160 Defibrillator: It was noted that the defibrillator was registered with the SW Ambulance Service and is in full working order.

23.5/161 Governance Statement: This statement was Approved by S. McNair-Scott and C. Hayne. Duly signed by the Chairman, S. McNair-Scott.

23/5/162 Accounting Statement: This statement was Approved by S. McNair-Scott and C. Hayne. Duly signed by the Chairman, S. McNair-Scott.

23/5/163 Community Chest Grant Request: Cllr. Jordan generously offered this Parish Meeting a grant of £500 from his Community Chest towards the cost of the installation of the defibrillator in Lesnewth. For this he was thanked.

23/5/164 Trees in the churchyard: A report still awaited from the Diocesan arboriculturist.

23/5/165 Matters of Public Interest / Date of next meeting: Next meeting to be held in September.
