

GCC Meeting August 19th 2021

Please see below the SEPA update.

**Calachem:** Two complaints received since our last update associated with a process operation resulting in the release of odour. We are continuing to work with the company towards earliest implementation of a long-term solution to reduce odour emissions.

**Petroineos:** Petroineos had an issue with the Vapour Recovery Unit at the road loading terminal on two occasions totalling nine days. This led to additional VOC emissions over this period. A repair has now been completed. A short-term exceedance of NOx on a small unit was also reported and is being followed up by SEPA. There was one odour complaint on 02 August, which was not substantiated.

**Ineos Chemicals:** The ethylene plant was shutdown on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August for planned maintenance. Two noise complaints reported. One on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> the other on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> Aug, SEPA are following up the potential source.

**Ineos FPS:** Train 3 has restarted following a maintenance shutdown.

**Ineos Infrastructure:** Nothing new to update.

**Versalis & Fuji:** Nothing to report
