Grangemouth Community Council – Update: 16 November 2023

INEOS Chemicals (ICGL): Planned flaring was undertaken at approximately 09:30 on 14th November for a duration of 3 hours. No complaints were received.

<u>Petroineos Refinery</u>: Investigations by Petroineos and the Health and Safety Executive into the fire incident in early September are ongoing. This will be reported to SEPA in due course.

The planned restart of some refinery units following the recent maintenance period has been further delayed. The restart will require low rates of elevated hydrocarbon and sulphur flaring and steam venting as units are brought into operation. Petroineos will update the community through the usual channels prior to this taking place.

Since the last update SEPA has not received any public complaints in relation to Refinery operations.

INEOS FPS Kinneil: No updates to report.
