NOTICE TO CREDITORS
THE Creditors of John Nisbet, mer-
chant in Eyemouth, at a meeting held by them on
the 24th of August current, under authority of the act of
the 23d of the King, entitled, "An act for rendering the
payment of creditors more equal and expeditious in that
part of Great Britain called Scotland," &c. unanimously
made choice of Thomas Potts, writer in Kello, to be inter-
im factor upon the said John Nisbet's sequestrated estate;

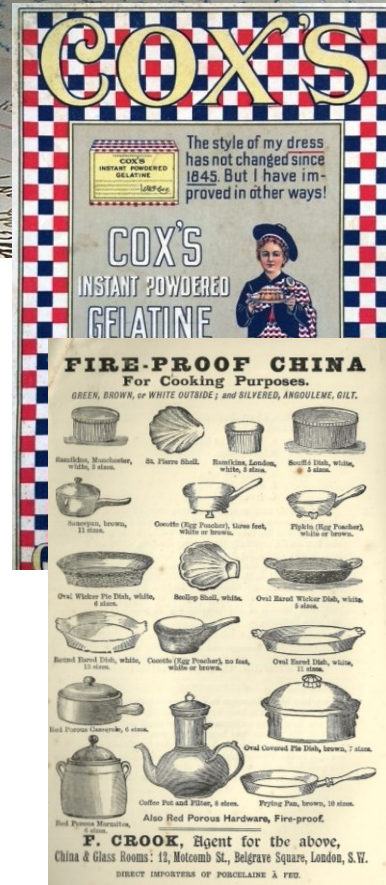
