Colder Weather on its way!!

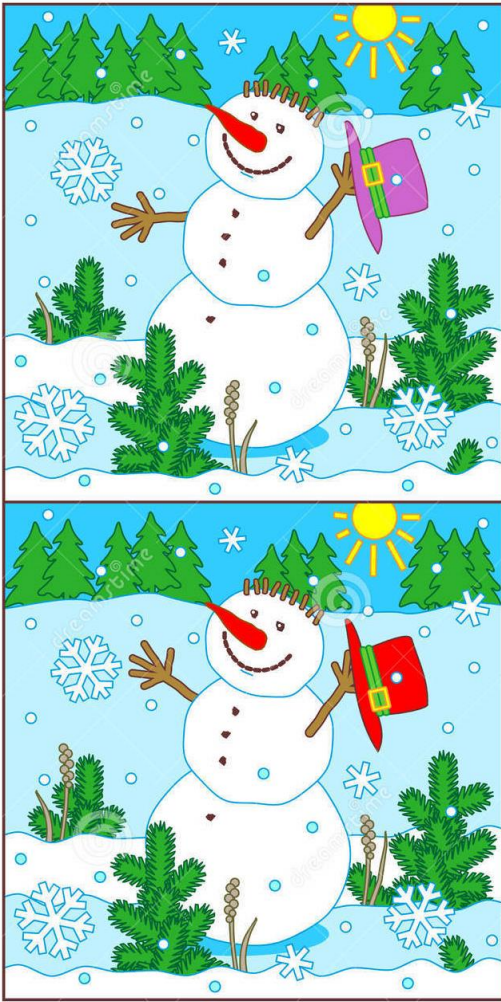
