Reporting of Pot Holes, Flooding and Blocked Drains

The recent weather has again taken its toll on the Coverdale roads. Please don't assume that someone else has reported any problems that you come across as the more reports NYCC get, the clearer picture they can get about the state of our roads. The reporting system for potholes, flooding, blocked drains etc is sent directly to the team which deals with the problem. They will send someone out within five days to assess the problem and work out a plan of action to remedy it if appropriate. NYCC have a huge network of roads to maintain and whilst they do patrol the network, they also rely on residents reporting problems. It's easy to do by accessing the following website:
