# 6. RESCINDING OF MINUTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDING ORDER 7(A)

In accordance with the Council's Standing Order 7(a), the Clerk has received written notification from Community Councillors A.Raines, G.Warren, G.Stacey and A.Green that they wish to reverse the following resolution made at the Council Meeting held on the 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2022 (Minute No.151) where it was resolved to adopt the following motion:-
