Street Scene



P Payne to follow up with a further email. Cllr. Turnbull suggested that East Riding Council should be asked to carry a risk assessment of the footpaths with a member of the Parish Council present. East Riding Council should be reminded that the need for repairs has been raised over a number of Street Scenes and apart from some minor repairs there has been a continuous deterioration over a number of years,

Environmental Agency

The Environmental Agency have requested a meeting with Skeffling & Welwick Parish Councils to explain further their plans for the Realignment Scheme. Cllr. Newsam to confirm the date of the 29th January at 7.00pm.
Cllr. Newsam had been contacted by the Holderness Gazette regarding the concerns that the Parish Council may have regarding the proposed Managed Realignment Scheme. Cllr. Newsam had already had contact with the Yorkshire Post and had informed them of the Council's concern over the disbursement of the surface water. It was agreed that Cllr. Newsam should communicate the same concerns to the Gazette.

Emergency Plan

After discussion, it was decided by majority vote, not to go ahead with an Emergency Plan for Skeffling. Cllr. Newsam and Cllr. Wykes voted in favour ✓ of having an Emergency Plan.

Playground
