045/20P The following applications were then discussed, and the Parish Council's comments were as follows:

Planning application: 03/20/00015

Location: Rose Cottage, Biddisham Lane, Biddisham Axbridge, Somerset, BS26 2RJ

Proposal: Erection of a 2 storey extension to the rear (East) elevation and erection of a

single storey extension to the side (South) elevation.

Applicant: Miss S Turner

Topics discussed: materials including windows and roof; the age of the cottage; roofing materials in the surrounding area; previous applications at the site; design of the proposal and finish, improved environmental rating of the new building works and increased living space.

Resolution: Recommend approval. Unanimously agreed.

Basis: The design and improved appearance.

Planning application: 03/20/00012 (As amended)

Location: Poplar Cottage, Bristol Road, Tarnock, Axbridge, Somerset, BS26 2SL

Proposal: Formation of a new access and track for agricultural purposes.

Applicant: Mr R Drinkwater

Topics discussed: previous response from the Parish Council and the additional information supplied; access to the agricultural buildings: the ditch between the buildings and field; public and consultee comments; current access.

Resolution: Recommend approval but would request that:

- 1. the surface at the field access should be concreted or similar for a short distance, in the interest of highway safety, as proposed in the application and
- that the existing property entrance should be stopped up upon construction of the new access, in the interest of highway safety, as proposed in the application.
 Unanimously agreed.

Basis: The requests of the Parish Council are included in the conditions of any approval.
