#### Minutes of previous meeting

### **Matters Arising**

VC had contacted the charity helicopter about a query regarding a helipad in Aberfeldy. SCAA confirmed they have no need for a dedicated helipad here.

EM had identified a suitable space for a commemorative bench for Ian Menzies at the Black Watch memorial. EM to contact Community Greenspace to make sure they are happy with proposal.

John Duff has asked PKC about additional floodlights in the Square. PKC have lit up the BWM at the moment and it looks very good.

#### **Crime Prevention and Community Safety**

Police Scotland not repreented and no CC issues for them. John Duff reported that there had been a spate of dog thefts locally, which had caused a lot of concern among owners.

### Coronavirus

The town was generally held to be doing well at the moment. Many people were worried about being locked down again. Feldy Roo were on standby again in case they were needed. Mention was made of other organizations in the town who were helping out as well. The PKC area had been placed in a different tier to Dundee. Incidences of the virus are believed to be very low in Highland Perthshire, but numbers of people in Ninewells were increasing, and hospitals in general are now coming under pressure.

Heartland Radio were very keen to help support groups by giving them a platform to make sure people knew what services they were able to offer.
