Pop-up Police

Both sets have been in use, since the repairs last month and will continue to be deployed about the town as and when there is help to deploy them.

Highland Road safety Action Partnership

Moving forward on staging "Night Driving Topic/Motorcycle safety training sessions/Older drivers safety sessions". The first of these is now scheduled for September 28th in Pitlochry with a re-run in Aberfeldy in planning. Precise format still being worked but details of the event will be released as soon as possible. Publicity material is being worked on right now. Please encourage everyone to circulate this early intelligence of the event and to look out for further news. This event is being staged in partnership with Police Scotland the Fire service and PKC's Community Safety Partnership.

Timber transport management follow up is held over while resources are put into the Pitlochry event, however, the situation in Glenlyon is being worked on actively and Timber Transport is part of it.

Working with PKC Traffic & Networks to progress on traffic calming once the policy is decided.

Trying to work on the model for getting PKC to progress community preferred actions, such as the Victoria Park entrance plan.

Meetings have been held at high level with PKC officers to look at how we can implement the issues that the Community highlights through our group.
