First of all, we hope that you are all safe and well and have had at least 1 if not 2 of your jabs. So here we are having navigated our way through the last 15 months of very difficult times in whichever way suited us best, and there is now light at the end of the tunnel. Since the Prime Minister announced his road map the bowling leagues have been working hard behind the scenes to sort out how to get the leagues up and running this year.

For all leagues this will be a one-off season with no promotion/relegation and the focus being on getting people back into bowling, and the intention to return to where we left off in 2019 at the start of 2022. For the Whitchurch and Drayton Leagues this means 8 teams per division and 10 players per team except for Division 1 in the Whitchurch league when there will be 12 players per team, and a different scoring system will be trialled for the season. The Barlows' League will see 8 teams per division and 8 players per team. We are also entering a team into the Market Drayton Seniors League this year.
