

## BRIDGEWATER BOWLING CLUB March 2021 Club Update




#### Dear Member

It seems along time since our last newsletter (December 2020), and much has happened since then, not least the development of a vaccine which will hopefully see us on track to a more normal life. Of course all bowling was cancelled last year, but we are hopeful of at least getting some league bowling going this year, and we hope that you will be looking forward to playing again this season, if you feel safe to do so. The exact details of when leagues will start is still being worked out based on the information we have from the roadmap that the Prime Minister outlined and from the information that we have from British Crown Green and Shropshire Crown Green. It is a tricky situation to sort out, as the sport itself is governed by the sports policies – which says we can start on 29<sup>th</sup> March, but the clubhouses/pubs etc that the greens belong to are governed by the 'hospitality' policies, and they are not allowed to open until April 12<sup>th</sup> for outside purchases/takeaways, and May 17<sup>th</sup> for indoor hospitality to start, and even then it is table service only. So a number of clubs have indicated that they will not open until all restrictions are lifted which is June 21<sup>st</sup> (fingers crossed). With all of this in mind the more likely start date for bowling this year will be first week in July, finishing the first week in October. The leagues will also probably take a different shape depending on how many clubs decide to enter, and how many teams. As soon as we have more information we will let you all know.

The groundsmen have been working hard all throughout last year and the winter to ensure that the greens are in the best possible condition for us when the league starts. Thanks must go to both Andy & Chris Pearce for all their hard work and time that they give to the club. We do intend to open the greens for practice from Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> April, but this will be subject to the booking system that we put in place last year and social distancing until restrictions are lifted. As a polite reminder, we agreed as a committee that the bowling subs, could be paid either last year or this year, and it would cover both seasons. For those of you who chose not to pay last year, then your subs are now due. These must be paid before you either go for a practice or you play for the club in the leagues, this will ensure you are covered by the clubs insurance, which is a stipulation of the British Crown Green Bowling Association. We were due to hold a hog roast last year, but like everything else it was postponed. We have rescheduled it for **Saturday 21**st **August** this year, and we hope that as many of you as possible will come along and bring your friends for a long-awaited night out and support the club.
