At our last meeting we were joined by Michael Morgan who is the Vale Councillor for the Peterston ward. He was welcomed by the Chair and stayed for the meeting. His priorities are to support the interests of the Rural Vale and, in particular, keeping older people in their communities and traffic problems in the narrow lanes.

THE POND BEHIND THE CHURCH: The Amphibian and Reptile Trust (a charitable organization) have agreed to take on maintenance of the pond. The area has become unkempt over the last year as we have had problems finding someone with a licence to do work on it. Maintenance work will start this autumn.

DOCUMENTS: A Local Resolution Protocol for Town and Community Councils was discussed, adopted and posted on the website.

FINANCE: Payments were made to GreenVenture Lawn and Weed for grass cutting in March (£280.00). The Annual Return was submitted to Wales Audit for scrutiny and changes were made to bank signatories to replace those who had left the Community Council.

PLANNING: A planning application 2017/00331/FUL at 6 Tair Onen has been approved by the Vale Council. Councillors discussed applications for Fairfield Welsh St Donats (17/00489/FUL) and 17 Tair Onen (17/ 00532/FUL). Further details are available on the Vale of Glamorgan Council website.

The Public Inquiry decision into activities at Hendrewennol is awaited.

Our next meetings are on the 4th July and 8th August, the Agenda will be displayed on the notice boards and website at least three clear days before the meeting. Residents are welcome and have the opportunity to speak to Councillors regarding any items on the Agenda at the start of the meeting.
