The agenda will be posted on the website and notice board in the bus shelter at Welsh St Donats at least three days before meetings.

AGM 2021: Emma Hall was elected to the Chair until the next AGM in May 2022. Nick Craddock was elected as Vice Chair. Members reviewed all the Community Council policies, risk assessments and register of assets and these are available for viewing on the Community Council website.

Mark Hasting will be representing the Community Council at One Voice Wales, Graham Duffield and Nick Craddock at the Vale Community Liaison Committee, Graham Duffield at the Village Hall Committee and Emma Hall at the PSECC Community Group.

ORDINARY MEETING:

HIGHWAYS AND FOOTPATHS: the Community Council continues to pursue with Natural Resources Wales problems over signage, public safety and the restoration of footpaths in the area of forest at Heol y March following recent tree felling operations. The condition of footpaths and stiles in other areas of the community has been raised the Vale Council PROW and we await a response.

FINANCES: Payments were approved for insurance (£3257.60), internal audit fees (£275.00) and grass cutting in April (£328.80).

REPRESENTATIVES: Nick Craddock attended a remote Community Liaison Committee meeting, at which police representation at community council meetings was raised as well as concerns over whether adequate provision was being made for schooling and healthcare in new areas of housing.

DOCUMENTS: Councillors reviewed the Race and Equality Plan from the Welsh Government and Project Zero from the Vale Council.

PLANNING APPLICATION: was considered for 16/00335/FUL Castell Talyfan (Amended)
