AGM 2022: Emma Hall was elected to the Chair until the next AGM in May 2023 and Natalie Bosworth was elected as Vice Chair. Members reviewed all the Community Council policies, risk assessments and register of assets. You will find these on the Community Council website.

Natalie Bosworth will be representing the Community Council at One Voice Wales and Ann Thomas at the Vale Community Liaison Committee. A representative on the Hall Committee will be decided at the next meeting.

ORDINARY MEETING:

VACANCIES ON THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL: following an uncontested election four vacancies remain on the Council. Efforts are underway to advertise widely in the community to fill these vacancies as quickly as possible.

REPORT FROM COUNTY COUNCILLOR MICHAEL MORGAN: Michael was congratulated on his re-election and he reiterated his commitment to continue pressing for road safety measures in rural areas of the Vale and care for senior citizens in their communities.

HIGHWAYS AND FOOTPATHS: the Community Council continues to pursue with the Vale Council problems over signage, road safety and the restoration of footpaths.

FINANCES: Payments were approved for insurance (£241), internal audit fees (£275.00) and grass cutting in April (£105). The accounts and summary 21-22 were discussed and approved and the Annual Return (Wales Audit) was completed, signed. All these are on the website.
