Jamie McIntyre and Jamie Tait talk about the Strontian Community School Board

Meeting started with a talk from Jaime T and Jaime M. They gave a short history of the origins of the primary school. Both were instrumental in getting the school built and both are on the Strontian Community School Board in the roles as Directors. However with their youngest children now in the senior phase at AHS they are keen to connect with parents at the P.C. and to get to know new parents with a view to getting parents to take on the responsibilities of supporting their community school.

Currently V.B.A is a co opted member of the SCSB and D MacKorkindale a Director. The board needs more parental support and more numbers, there are some issues that need to be taken on.

Recently, the school playground has had some drainage issues successfully resolved.

The front area of the school requires some work, idea is to create a wild flower area with paths running through it. Raised beds could also be used? Up to parents working with the school.

Back area of school possibly looking at developing heather on back bank, and bushy shrubs such as willow.

Grass cutting is not carried out by H.C. as they deem the school grounds too dangerous. This position has not been accepted by SSCB. SSCB have joined forces with parents/staff to cut the grass/ rushes using their own equipment, H.C. are aware of this. *More parents are needed to help with this.* Possible opportunity to use Grounds Maintenance money from HC for SSCB and PC funds. Negotiations are ongoing *and parents are needed to help support these issues.*

Groundworks, a discussion followed. This depends on how the grounds are developed and could be low maintenance.

MMC mentioned a possible more sculpted area around the rock area out front with paths through the wild flower meadow.

Discussion on stone circle area.

The school was built for the community and parents now need to take responsibility for it. Who can commit?

A 15 year mortgage on building which can become houses or developed in the future. H.C. have agreed to this 2027/8 breakpoint on this- PPI coincides with the PPI at High School / Possibility of moving SP into AHS/ general feeling of the community not for this.

If this does happen in 2028 the PS can be divided into 4 houses. SCSB prefer to stay based at the PS.
