Continuous Profiling and Reporting, and Parental engagement and family learning including M&T and assessment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will fully implement the Continuous Profiling and reporting programme to achieve sign-off with the associated reduced bureaucracy in final reporting • We will improve our school tracking and implement the Highland Council's (prepopulated) template, to better plan interventions and monitor progress

Leadership and the 3-18 Campus including curriculum Leadership and ELC expansion and vision, values, aims</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will implement the planned 3-18 campus model for Ardnamurchan High School and Strontian Primary School, appointing a Principle Teacher (primary) to strengthen leadership in the primary. We will appoint an additional teacher to fully staff the primary school. • Savings against the Head Teacher (primary) salary will be deployed to build capacity to support the DHT (secondary) and office functions (primary) • The Head Teacher will continue to strengthen the leadership functions in the Primary and team approach across the 3-18 campus • Annual consultation/questionnaire will be brought in to support identifying areas for improvement • We will plan for our ELC expansion to 1140 hrs for 2020/21
