

AND TESTAMENT of me

DONALD FERLYS WILSON BADEN-POWELL of 9 Benson Place in the City of Oxford Esquire I APPOINT my Son FRANCIS ROBERT BADEN-POWELL of 32 Saint Luke's Street Chelsea S.W.3. in the County of Greater London Architect and NATHANIEL REID SHARMAN of 35 Bedford Row W.C.1. in the said County of Greater London Solicitor (hereinafter together called "my Trustees") to be my EXECUTORS and the TRUSTEES of this my Will I GIVE to the said NATHANIEL REID SHARMAN if he shall prove my Will the sum of ONE HUNDRED POUNDS free of duty I GIVE to the PITT RIVERS MUSEUM Oxford free of duty my collection of stone implements and all other my scientific specimens together with all treatises manuscripts notebooks maps and papers relative thereto I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all my estate both real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever not hereby or by any Codicil hereto otherwise disposed of SUBJECT to payment thereof of my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts unto my said Son absolutely if he shall be living at the date of my death but if he shall predecease me then I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the same subject as aforesaid unto such child or children of my said Son as shall survive me and attain the age of Twenty-one years and if more than one in equal shares I HEREBY DECLARE that in the event of any minority interest arising under this my Will necessitating the investment of capital moneys the same may be laid out in or upon any investments or securities whether authorised or not by law for the investment of trust funds as my Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit I HEREBY FURTHER DECLARE that any Executor or Trustee of this my Will being a Solicitor or other person engaged in any profession or business may be so employed and shall be entitled to charge and be paid all proper professional and other charges for any business or act done by him or his firm in connection with the administration of my estate and any trusts arising hereunder including any act which an Executor or Trustee not being a Solicitor or other person engaged as aforesaid could have done personally AND LASTLY I HEREBY REVOKE all Wills and testamentary dispositions at any time heretofore made by me AND DECLARE this to be and contain my true last Will and


