OBJECTIVES AS DISCUSSED WITH HIGHLAND COUNCIL


- Reduce building strikes by vehicles on Bank Street
- Reduce vehicle speeds on A832 Denny Road especially going down the hill
- Improve sightlines at key junctions on High Street
- Prevent large vehicles using The Paye
- Reduce congestion on Church Street

- Improve the turning manoeuvres at Marine Terrace Bank Street junction
- Restrict parking on High Street Denny Road corner

PROPOSALS

Put forward by Highland Council and for discussion. We can adopt none, some, all of these proposals.



1. Junction of Marine Terrace and Bank Street

- Mark the road as a proper junction with appropriate road markings
- Shevron an area outside the public bar door of the Royal Hotel
- Make it clear who has right of way




2. Junction of High Street and Bank Street

- No parking on narrowest section of Bank Street at the High Street end
- Signage indicating that the area is not suitable for large vehicles
- Option of one-way if above measures don't alleviate the issues



3. Church Street

- One way system for Church Street to reduce the issue of traffic meeting head-on
- Restricted parking at junction with Forsyth Place
- Signage to indicate that Church
 Street is not appropriate for large vehicles



4. THE PAYE


Proposal:

 Unsuitable for large vehicles signage at both ends of the Paye to discourage lorries, vans etc from using it



5. DENNY ROAD

- Introduce 'Priority for uphill traffic' system at the bottom of the Denny (gate to Stroopie)
- Similar set-up to the entrance to Munlochy
- Further option to reduce parking at the junction at the very bottom of the Denny
