FOOD BANK COLLECTIONS

Did you know there are Food Bank Collections? Non-perishable food can be placed in the box in the Church porch, collection is every Wednesday before 9.30am fortnightly. The next collections are 10 & 24 November. These items can be placed in the box anytime between collection dates. Thank you.

FIX MY STREET (FORMALLY STREET DOCTOR)

All villagers are reminded that any problems with potholes, overgrown verges, empty salt bin etc can be reported directly to Fix My Street – NCC would prefer contact to be made online and have advised that “If the problem is categorised as an emergency, then the phone number will appear for people to ring instead.” In addition, any problems with overgrown public footpaths etc should be reported in the same manner. It is also helpful to take a photograph of the problem as this can be uploaded when reporting the problem. PLEASE NOTE – do not undertake any practical work on the Rights of Way network **however minor**, including the repair of furniture or cutting back overhanging vegetation. Any repairs and all practical work required must be reported via Street Doctor.

Problems with the streetlights however must be reported to the Clerk as these need to be directed to E.on.

ROAR!

REDUCING HANNINGTON VILLAGE'S ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT - EVERY LITTLE HELPS!

What can I do? Using the ROAR scheme would be a good start!

What's that? A scheme which provides for the recycling of many items not recyclable under the current Council scheme.

What do I have to do? Just take your items (see below) to the ROAR bin situated just inside the gates at The Cottage, School Lane.

What items can I take? A full list is provided on the Village Notice Board and on the bin itself. It includes crisp, biscuit, cake, sweet, ice cream wrappings, pet food wrappings, toothpaste/brush/accessories, cheese wrappings, bread bags, blister packets from tablets, flexible packaging from cleaning and washing products, writing materials, ink cartridges, can ring holders.

What happens to the items I take? They are sorted into the different categories, flat packed and once a month they are taken to Old where they are packaged up and sent to Terracycle and similar organisations. A small amount of funds is generated as a result and this is donated to such organisations as Walgrave Primary School and Headstart, Kettering. See ROAR! on Facebook and the Terracycle website for more details.

Anything else? Please ONLY put the items listed in the ROAR bin. In particular frozen food, vegetable and fruit bags, cling film, rice and noodle packaging are NOT currently recyclable under the scheme.

All items have to be flat packed for transportation, so please - try not to screw your packaging up!!
