PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCIES

The Parish Council currently has two vacancies that can be filled by co-option. To qualify, a person must be a Commonwealth citizen or EU national, over 18 years of age and an elector, must reside within the parish of Hannington,

or within 3 miles of it, or occupy as owner or tenant any land or premises therein, or have their principal or only place of work there, and must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor. Please contact the Clerk if you are interested in filling these positions.
