The Rotary Club of Forfar is proud to present its seventh Classic Car Tour. The 2024 event is again in aid of CHAS (Children's Hospices Across Scotland) which we have supported over the last two years.

We are planning an interesting drive of approximately 120 miles covering one of the most beautiful parts of Scotland, over mainly quiet and scenic roads. A lunch has been arranged at the Moness Resort at Aberfeldy again, which was such a great success last year and the tour will end with a meal at picturesque Glamis Castle. There are ample photo opportunities at the Castle.

We are grateful to our main sponsors, Fisken Motor Group and Guild Homes, and all our other sponsors for their help and support.

For over twenty years Children's Hospices Across Scotland (CHAS) has been offering a full family support service for babies, children and young people with life-shortening conditions. This includes palliative care, family respite and support – through hospices, homecare services and hospital presence. Recent research has shown that three children die each week from life-shortening conditions, but that CHAS is reaching only one in three of these children and their families. CHAS's ambition is that every family in Scotland living with the heart-breaking knowledge that their child is dying will be supported and cared for to make the most of their precious time together.

Strathmore Classic Car Tour Regulations

1. Announcement

The Strathmore Classic Car Tour will be held on Sunday 23rd June 2024 and is organised by The Rotary Club of Forfar. The event will start in Forfar and finish at Glamis Castle.

2. Car Eligibility

All Vintage, Historic and Classic Cars, including Modern Sports Cars are welcome.

3. Entries

The Entry List will close on 15th June 2023 and may be limited to 60 cars.

There is **no entry fee** for what is promised to be a day of fun and fellowship amongst like-minded classic car enthusiasts, but all entrants will be expected to **raise sponsorship of a minimum of £50 per car** with 100% of the proceeds going to the Children's Hospices Across Scotland (CHAS).

4. Donations and Sponsorship

Please seek donations and sponsorship from friends, family and business associates to assist in raising funds by completing the sponsorship form. **If the sponsorship is given by a UK taxpayer, please complete the form with their name, address and postcode. This will allow us to claim back 25% in Gift Aid**

All donations will go to the Rotary Club of Forfar Charitable Trust for distribution to Children's Hospices Across Scotland (CHAS).

The sponsorship form together with the monies collected should ideally be handed in on the day to your Registration Desk but may be sent not later than 7 days after the event to David Stobbs, 3 Slatefield Rise, Forfar. DD8 1XB. Please make any cheques payable to The Rotary Club of Forfar Charitable Trust.

4. Route Navigation and Driving Behaviour

The route will be on public A and B class and some unclassified roads. The route will be defined by Tulip diagrams. A Road Book and Map will be provided.

Please remember other road users, cyclists, walkers and livestock. Please do not hold up the traffic.

Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a sensible and responsible manner. Drivers should give due consideration to weather and road conditions.

In the event of a traffic accident/incident drivers must follow normal reporting procedures.

5. Qualification/Licences

There will be absolutely no element of competition, so no special qualifications are needed! A full UK driving licence is all that is required.

6. Insurance

Insurance is solely the responsibility of the driver. Normally no special insurance is required for a Classic Car Tour, however you are advised to check with your Insurance provider whether you will be covered for this type of event. A minimum of Third-Party Insurance for all persons who will drive participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

7. Scrutineering

The car must have a valid Road Fund Licence, MOT Certificate (if applicable) and Certificate of Insurance. The Driver will be required to sign a declaration confirming the car is insured and road legal at the Reception Desk. Both the Driver and Passengers will be also required to sign a declaration indemnifying the Organisers from liability on a Signing On Sheet.

8. Controls

Route Check Code Boards may be in place to establish that the correct route has been followed.

9. Data Protection

Prospective entrants and participants are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on a computer and used for the administration of the event only. No information will be passed on to third parties.

10. Final Instructions

These will be sent out w/c 10th June and will include directions to the Start venue.

11. Goody Bag

At the Start Venue each driver will be issued with a Goody Bag containing:

Rally Plate with ties.

Souvenir Awards for all entrants.
