



North Mongolia

This shows the route taken by 4x4's from Ulaan Baatar via Morun and Bulgan to Hovsgol Nuur National Park. The return journey goes via Morun to Erdenet where we take the overnight sleeper train on the Trans Mongolian railway.

Hovsgol Nuur NP

The Old Russian route follows a system of valleys and ridges to cross the Horidal Saridag Range in a South Eastern direction. It starts in Renchenlumbe and takes four long days to reach Hatgal at the Southern end of Hovsgol Nuur (lake). It offers superb scenery and the chance to see some of Mongolia's rare wildlife such as the Red Wolf, Brown Bear, Argali Sheep and maybe the most elusive of all, the Snow Leopard.

At the Southern end of Hovsgol flows the Eggin Gol (river) which makes a very good 2-6 day Open Canoe journey.
