6. **Repair to Well bench.** The bench has been reported as being in need of maintenance and the council is asked to authorise the clerk to proceed within the limits of the financial regulations.
7. **Planning: DA/2020/0413.** Demolition of conservatory and erection of single-story rear extension at 4 Stanford Close. Councillors are asked for observations.
8. **Insurance:** to report progress on separate insurance quotes from October 2020 for the PC and CAPFA
9. **APNR camera initiative:** members are asked to respond to the circulated email from Northants police
10. **Cemetery charges:** it was agreed in June that charges would be reviewed on the basis of comparative data from nearby villages. The data has been collected and sent to members. It is suggested that the data is examined at the meeting and proposals for changes (price and date of implementation) submitted to the September meeting, or the annual meeting.
