- 4. Police report:** PC Barr summarised the Police Report received from PC Johnston, which noted a number of incidents of a routine nature, mainly Road Traffic related. Cllr Green reported having received a particularly convincing fraudulent email in recent days.

Matters Arising: Tralee Road:** surfacing work now completed, expecting line painting to follow shortly. **Breedons Liaison Meeting:** took place on 13th May; there is now a single manager for both Bonawe & Culcharron, Chris Johnston. Concerns were raised over the operation of the one-way system (Bonawe Road & B845) – Breedons agreed that vehicle ID numbers would be re-introduced to simplify reporting, and a new contact sheet was provided. It was agreed to continue to meet regularly. **Lochnell School Crossing:** The planned May meeting has been postponed to 5th June. BEAR have indicated that they have some engineering plans to discuss with the group.
