

Directions for Speakers

Follow signs for Paisley & Glasgow Airport. Be careful not to exit onto the A737 which is signposted for Irvine. It is best to stay in the middle lane when passing the Airport as this leads naturally to the St James' Interchange slipway. Stay **LEFT** on the slipway. At the interchange take the **FIRST LEFT** onto a dual carriageway with some football fields on the left hand side. This road is signposted at the interchange as **East Kilbride A726**. Follow this road and after a sharp right-hand bend you will be in Greenock Road which continues into Caledonia Street. Continue along to traffic lights at a T-junction. Take **RIGHT** turn into Underwood Road along to a round-a-bout. Take **immediate LEFT** turn into Well Street and at the next set of traffic lights turn **LEFT** into Wellmeadow Street. Before you reach a further set of traffic lights you will see the Museum/Library building to your left. The University is on the right-hand side. This journey should take about 10 minutes. There is a small car-park at the side of the museum. If this is full, on-road parking is permitted. If the museum doors are shut, there is a door at the side of the building with a bell-push. The staff inside will give you access and some tea or coffee from the machine. A good-quality digital projector is provided by the museum plus a laptop and a screen. You may prefer to use your own laptop. There is a café across the road from the museum which serves light snacks.

The meeting will start at around **7.30pm** and our Chairman, Tom Byars, will ask the members for any interesting recent sightings. At around 7.45, Tom will introduce you to the society.
