Ongoing Items of Business	<p>There's some concern about the <b>traffic lights</b> outside Ballachulish causing confusion for traffic. David Smith is to contact the Police to ask them to have a look to see if traffic management can be made clearer for road users.</p> <p>No further updates on the <b>Ambulance Station</b> move. They are still waiting for the parking space to be built before they can move in.</p> <p><b>Planning List</b> – nothing in the local area on the list.</p> <p><b>Community Compost Site:</b> The compost site is becoming busy again after the winter lull. Anne Nelson will be taking more of a back seat but will still help down there. Sheena Ounsworth from North Ballachulish has been recruited to work on the site.</p> <p><b>An Annual Membership Fee</b> to use the site of £10 is being introduced. This will be paid into CC funds and will help to cover the cost to hire a larger chipper and equipment for the site to help cope with the large amounts of material being brought in. Over 20T of material was processed on site last year.</p> <p><b>Village Notice Board</b> – Gwen has made enquiries about the notice board in the car park. It turns out that it is designated for Tourist Board information only. It is felt by the CC that more relevant local information should be provided for visitors such as bus timetables, taxi phone numbers, information on places to visit ie: lochan, where to get food and events etc. It was decided to look into purchasing and putting up our own notice board in that location.
