Minutes from the last meeting of 13th September:

David Smith asked for one amendment to be made to the Minutes: that the Community Company funding application to be before the 1st November.

Matters arising from the last meeting:

David Doogan said that he had attended a Forestry Commission meeting on 20th September in Torlundy which was looking at the long term management and development of local forested areas owned by the commission.

Sepa have been in touch asking the forestry commission to draw up a strategy to tackle the knot weed problem in the area.

David Smith reported that the handrails have been put up at the footpath along the play park leading onto the Kinlochleven Road.

The various pot holes in the village road have been filled in.

Transerve hasn't yet been contacted about clearing the ditches along the A82.

David Doogan reminded the meeting that the Community Council elections are coming up nominations have to be in by 4pm on 5th October.

Open forum:

David D asked Billy Kinnear about staffing at the police station, currently there is a sergeant and 5 police constables based at the Glencoe station. There are 2 police on duty at any one time. 3 live in the village.

Anne had obtained a quote for another 2 new Christmas lights and it was decided to go ahead with and order for these. It is to be arranged for the Christmas lights to go up in mid December.

David D asked Anne to arrange to put the benches from the view point under cover for the winter.

Community Company:

David Smith reported that the Planning application is still to be sent in. There's been a slight postponement with the path along one section and once that is sorted out in the next few days then it will be submitted.
