# **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES & MATTERS ARISING**

Minutes of meeting 17<sup>th</sup> April 2012 – proposed IMT, seconded GMT.

IMT spoke to Craig Millar (Forestry Commission) regarding a number of questions relating to the Lochan:

- 1. picnic benches have been removed for repair/replacement and will be reinstated shortly
- litter FC has no budget for clean-up; Thomas Janzen suggested organizing a volunteer litter pick
- 3. improving signage at the fork to the Lochan (concerns were raised at the previous meeting regarding oversize vehicles taking the Glencoe House road where there is limited provision for turning) FC happy to address
- 4. fishing licences FC confirms that no one is retailing fishing licences for 2012; IMT to investigate what is involved in re-establishing licence sales

# **FINANCIAL MATTERS**

DS confirms the annual grant from Highland Council has been paid.

# **INVITED GUESTS**

PC Joe Newson introduced himself to the new CC and asked whether there were any issues with which the police could help. No major problems were identified; matters raised included speeding in Glencoe village, an instance of underage drinking at the tidal pool, and inappropriate fire lighting by campers. With regard to such concerns, PC Newson advised phoning the Glencoe police station at the time to enable the duty officers to investigate and respond appropriately. Lastly, PC Newson reported that there had been some incidents in the area of theft from open boats.

#### **RED KITE**

#### **OLYMPIC TORCH**

Extensive correspondence regarding the Torch Visit on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June. DS had further information from Highland Council: a "pre-activation" convoy will come by 45 minutes before the torch with sponsor vehicles handing out samples. Highland Council have made a site visit and favour the area to the South of Glencoe Hotel for spectators. Glencoe Hotel is proposing to put on free "children's party food", and parents from some of the local primary schools plan to organize races around the visit and food. Kinlochleven High School may be able to provide some bunting.

Still trying to find a piper. Currently with AS.

Serious traffic disruption on the A82 is likely. Spectators should be aware that parking in Glencoe village is very limited.

# **COMMUNITY COMPANY**

### **AOCB**

DS and AS attended a meeting of the A82 Working Group on 10<sup>th</sup> May. Among the items discussed:

- 1. A82 closure for work in the area of Pulpit Rock, 2013. Expected to be closed continuously from September through to Christmas.
- 2. Flooding of cycle path at end of Tighphuirst and at Craigrannoch is to be addressed. [IMT also mentioned damage from the cycle path construction to fences between the Glencoe filling station and snow gates which needs repair.]

Compost Heap: Grass opposite compost heap needs periodic cutting over summer. GMT to organize. Also, benches need uncovering; plants for tubs.
