#### **Notes to the Accounts**

#### 31 March 2011

#### 1. Principal Accounting Policies

#### **Accounting Convention**

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Accounting Guidance Notes for Local Councils (the Guide) issued by The Chartered Institute of Public Finance (CIPFA) as applicable to a medium sized council.

As a consequence the latest accounting policies, as set out in the Guide and so far as they apply to this Council have been adopted for the Council's statement of account.

#### Fixed Assets

All expenditure on the acquisition, creation or enhancement of fixed assets is reported in the notes to the accounts, provided that the fixed asset yields benefits the authority and the services it provides, for a period of more than one year. Fixed assets are valued on the basis recommended by CIPFA. The year-end values are stated on the following basis;

Land, operational properties and other operational assets are reported in notes to the accounts at cost or at approximate cost amounts. Certain community assets are subject of restrictive covenants as to their use and/or future disposal. Such assets are therefore considered to have no appreciable realisable value and are included at a nominal value only.

#### Capital receipts

Capital receipts arising from the disposal of fixed assets are taken to a Capital Receipt Reserve until such time as they are used to finance new capital expenditure.

#### **Debtors and Creditors**

The revenue accounts of the council are maintained on an accrual basis in accordance with the guide. That is sums due to or from the council during the year are included whether or not the cash has actually been received or paid in the year. Exceptions to this are payment of insurance premiums and regular quarterly accounts (e.g. telephones, electricity). This policy is applied consistently each year. Therefore, it will not have a material effect on the year's accounts or on the council's annual budget.

#### External Loan Repayments

The Council has no long-term borrowing. Consequently, there were no external loan repayments made in the year.

#### Leases

The Council has no commitments under finance leases. Rentals payable under operating leases are charged to revenue on accruals basis.

#### Reserves

The Council maintains certain reserves to meet general and specific future expenditure. The purpose of the Council's reserves is explained in note 13.

#### 16. Grant funding

During the last financial year the Council received £25,000 in grant funding for the proposed BMX/skate park project, which unfortunately the Council resolved not to proceed with following legal advice. £15,000 was returned to the funders last financial year and £10,000 was returned to Daventry District Council this financial year.

#### 17. Brixworth Community Centre

During the year the Community Centre became a registered charity and a new bank account was opened in December 2010. The Parish Council opened the new account with a sum of £2,000.00, which the Community Centre is to repay at a later date. As from next year the Community Centre will have separate statement of accounts.
