1	Meeting commenced with <b>CM</b> welcoming all to the meeting, especially <b>MA</b> and <b>LB</b> as potential new members.	
2	Convenors report (see attached) was presented by CM as she detailed a highly successful year and GALA which is obviously well supported and enjoyed by the local community. However, a continuing poor attendance and low committee membership once again places the GALA continuation in jeopardy.	
3	Treasurer's Report  GM presented the Treasurers report (see attached) detailing all income and expenditure for the year. The GALA Week currently has a very healthy bank balance of £4,902.13 to take forward into 2012.	
4	Resignation of Committee Members CM (Convenor) and GM (Treasurer) tendered their resignation from the committee. Both are long term and highly valued committee members who will be greatly missed. They were thanked for their enormous efforts and energy given to the committee over the past 3 and 4 years respectively.	
5	<ol> <li>ELECTION OF OFFICE BEARERS</li> <li>Discussion regarding the future of the 2012 GALA took place before the Election of Office Bearers. The volume of work and time commitment given by the GALA committee members last year was unanimously agreed as unsustainable. Without sufficient numbers and a continued dwindling membership KS advised that unless the format of the GALA Week changed she would not be able to put herself forward as committee member.</li> <li>SM advised that she would reluctantly continue as Secretary this year but minuted that she would be resigning at the next AGM.</li> <li>EA advised that she was willing to join as a new member but her time commitment would be limited depending on shift work.</li> <li>SG advised that Fiona Ross had put herself forward as a new member but had been unable to attend the AGM.</li> <li>LB advised that she could not join the committee due to a conflict of interest with her job as Community Development Worker but she offered her help with fundraising and other support.</li> <li>It was agreed that Officer Bearers would be elected and the format of the GALA week would change to a weekend event or Fun Day. The details would be further determined at the next meeting.</li> <li>TM was proposed as Convenor by KS and seconded by ES.
