1	The main item on the agenda was to determine if we had enough committee members to make a Gala possible this year. Despite publicity for the AGM, posters and recent blackboard notices and posters no new members have come forward to join the committee. After discussion it was agreed that:	
	1) There are simply not enough members to enable the Gala to take place in 2012 in the usual format. The current 6 committee members all work full time, 50% working shifts and therefore not able to commit to events in advance and all members have limited time they will be available to commit during Gala week. It is better to cancel now rather than organise events and have to cancel at short notice.	
	2) All agreed that the committee would attempt to hold a very limited number of events this year, continue to advertise for new committee members and trust that new members come forward at the AGM in November 2012. In the event this is not successful decision will then be taken regarding the overall future of the Gala Week charity and committee.
