Hurworth - Geneva Woods - Burma Road

(paths 14,17,18+1) Approx. 4-5 miles

Meet Peter Foster at the Christmas tree on Hurworth village green at 6.30pm.

Where we will make our way towards Glebe view farm, taking the path past Blackwell moor farm to Geneva Woods, crossing behind the football stadium, passing high farm and joining Burma road to the footpath exciting along coach lane

Wednesday 9th August 2017

Neasham circuit

Approx. 3 miles

Meet Peter Foster at The Fox and Hounds Neasham at 6.30pm.

From there we will make our way to Cold Comfort Farm then on through to the wood on the site of the old brick works, across the fields to Neasham hill and back into Neasham



Wednesday 16th August 2017

Hurworth Moor

Paths 1,5,6,7,4,3 & BW2 - Approx 4-5 miles

Meet Peter Foster at the Christmas tree on Hurworth village green at 6.30pm.

Walking along coach lane, behind the allotments to Timmies Lane and on up to Neasham Springs, then along the byway to Low Maidendale Farm, joining the footpath to Hurworth Moor and along Burma road, crossing Neasham road and taking FP1 back into Hurworth Village
