<u> Hurworth – Geneva Woods – Burma Road</u>

(paths 14,17,18+1) Approx. 4-5 miles

Meet Peter Foster at the Christmas tree on Hurworth village green at 6.30pm. Where we will make our way towards Glebe view farm, taking the path past Blackwell moor farm to Geneva Woods, crossing behind the football stadium, passing high farm and joining Burma road to the footpath exciting along coach lane

## Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2017

<u> Timmies Lane – Neasham</u>

(paths 5,6+7) Approx 3 miles

Meet Janine Forster at the Christmas tree on village green at 11.30am Walking through Coach Lane, passing the allotments to Timmies Lane, following the path to spring cottage, Neasham Springs and passing garden nurseries into Neasham.

The walk will end at the Fox and Hounds at Neasham, where walkers can make their own way back to Hurworth in their own time.
