## Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2017

Neasham circuit - Approx. 2 miles

Meet Peter Foster at The Fox and Hounds Neasham at 6.30pm.
From there we will make our way up the bank to Middleton, leaving the road to take the path by Cold Comfort Farm then on to Low Maidendale Farm then back through Neasham Springs and down into Neasham

### Sunday 28th May 2017

Canny Well Woods, Croft - (paths 11 & 12) Approx. 2 miles

Meet Janine Forster at Hurworth Grange at 10.30am.

From here past the doctors' surgery and joining path 11, coming out at the railway bridge, making our way over Croft river bridge, and take the road towards Middleton Tyas, where we take up the footpath through Canny Well Woods. (There is an old small sulphur well along this root if anyone wants a look) We then take the farm track back towards Croft passing by Stand Alone house back along Croft road, over Croft bridge and using path 12 (the Glebe) we make our way to the Grange.



#### Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2017

#### Rockcliffe river walk -(paths 9, 21, 11 & 10) Approx 3 miles

Meet Janine Forster at the Christmas tree on Hurworth village green 6.30pm Following the river through the ringfield, passing Rockcliffe Farm and Low Rockcliffe, round the river to the viaduct using paths 9 & 21. From here along the edge of football training pitches coming out onto path 11 and taking this and byway 10 back to the village green.

#### Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2017

Eryholme - Approx. 4-5 miles

Meet Peter Foster at the Christmas tree on Hurworth village green at 6.30pm. From here over the bridge, through the farm and up to Eryholm scar.
