### Terms and Conditions 2014

1. Hurworth Show Committee reserve the right to make corrections and additions to the Terms and Conditions, as and when necessary.
2. Please check the website [www.hurworthcountryfair.co.uk](http://www.hurworthcountryfair.co.uk) for the latest updates.
3. On site drop off is limited to wheelchair users and disabled badge holders.
4. Disabled badge holders and drivers may park in the school's staff car park.
5. No exhibitor car parking allowed at the Grange or on the show site on show day.
6. Car parking arrangements will be signposted and are as follows: across the road behind Hurworth Maths and Computing Collage and in the field next to the Rockliffe Court.
7. Photographs, paintings and handicrafts can be brought to the Fletcher Hall on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September for the Committee to display. Exhibitor set up is 8 a.m. to 9.45a.m. Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2014. Flower arrangements can be set up 1pm to 3.30pm on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September.
8. At 9.45am the show area will be closed to exhibitors and the public for the duration of Judging.
9. The show area will reopen when Judging is complete.
10. All exhibits must remain on show until 4:15 p.m. after presentations and collected before 5:30 p.m.
11. Perishable exhibits left after 5:30 p.m. will be disposed of.
12. Other exhibits will be held for 24 hours at the owner's risk and afterwards disposed of at the Committee's discretion.
13. With the exception of flower arranging classes 36 to 39, all exhibits MUST have been, grown, sewn, painted, created, or made, by the named exhibitor's own efforts.
14. The exhibitor's name must not be visible on any exhibit.
15. An exhibit previously placed first, in any show or fair, may not to be entered at Hurworth.
16. The Judges decision is final.
17. Trophies, shields and cups are awarded for one year only and must be returned to the Grange Community Centre office before entry closing day the following year.
18. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry and return fees without explanation: they reserve the power to cancel any class with fewer than three entrants.
19. The Committee do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to produce or personal property during the time they are on show; all entries are received subject to this condition.
20. Show entry forms and fees can be registered at the following times:  
Monday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2pm to 4pm and 6pm to 8pm  
Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2pm to 4pm and 6pm to 8pm  
Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2pm to 4pm and 6pm to 8pm. **No late entries accepted.**
