5. Financial Review

The updated Financial Report had been circulated to all councillors, and was accepted; this included all of the suggested projects as distributed on the Project Schedule.

A Summary of the Available funds was presented which showed the net amount available for projects over the next 24 months. This amounted to £49,000, after allowing for the statutory contingency.
