The table above shows the colour of horseshoes more likely to win in each race type. Please note the following:

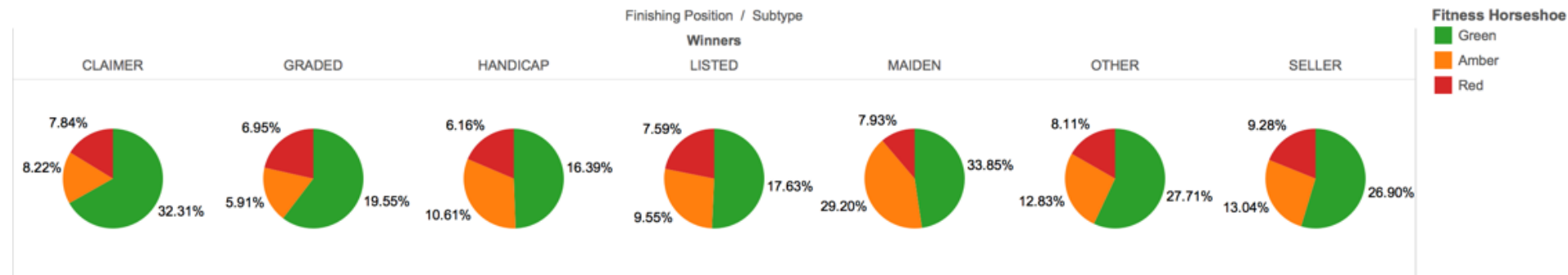
- You can find the race type by reading the race title on the BetTurtle app (click the information icon) or by clicking 'Cards' and then 'Search Races' on the BetTurtle website menu.
- Red horseshoes will win, but be wary taking short odds on a horse with red horseshoes. The more red, the bigger the price should be.
- Green horseshoes will win their fair share of races. However, be guided by price, as they can offer poor value, especially when the vibe horseshoe is green.

# The following slides provide a detailed analysis of BetTurtle's horseshoe ratings.

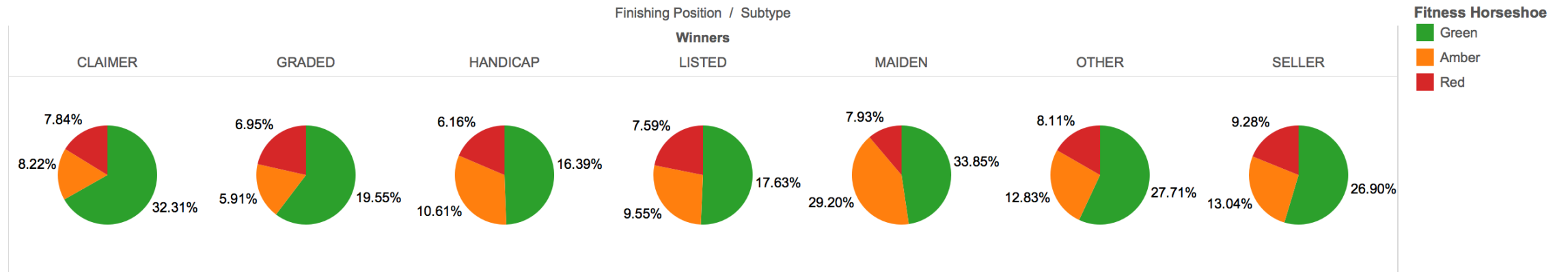
- The pie charts use a variable, strike rate by category, for each of the Horseshoe categories (Fitness, Ability, Vibes, etc).
- **Strike rate by category** – Win strike rate of a colour of horse shoe in a type of race. This is calculated by dividing the total number of winning horseshoes for each colour and dividing it by the total number of horses that raced with that horseshoe colour. So if there have been a 100 races and 200 horses with red fitness horseshoes raced and 20 of them won, then the red fitness strike rate is 20 divided by 200 multiplied by 100 = 10%. This pie chart's scores do not add up to 100%.

# Fitness **green** horseshoes should be of interest in all races...

Strike Rate By Fitness Horseshoe Colour

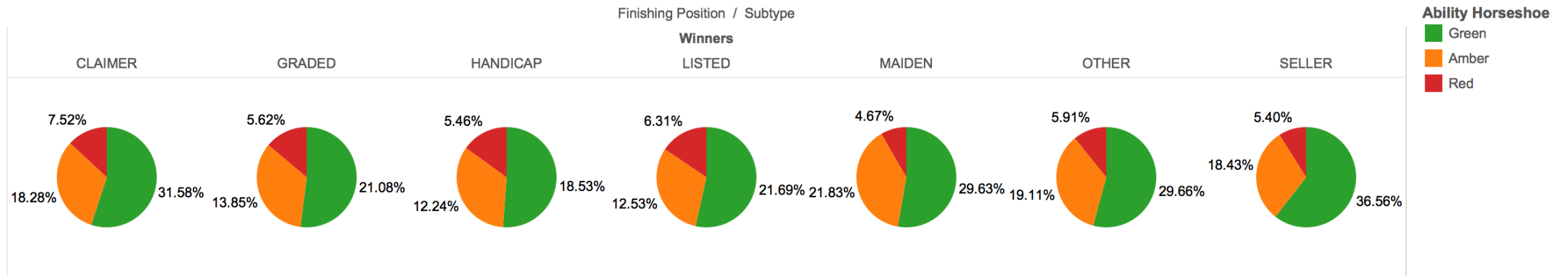


... red horseshoes should be avoided, but occasionally consider ambers, especially in maiden races.



# Ability green horseshoes should be of interest in all races...

Strike Rate By Ability Horseshoe Colour

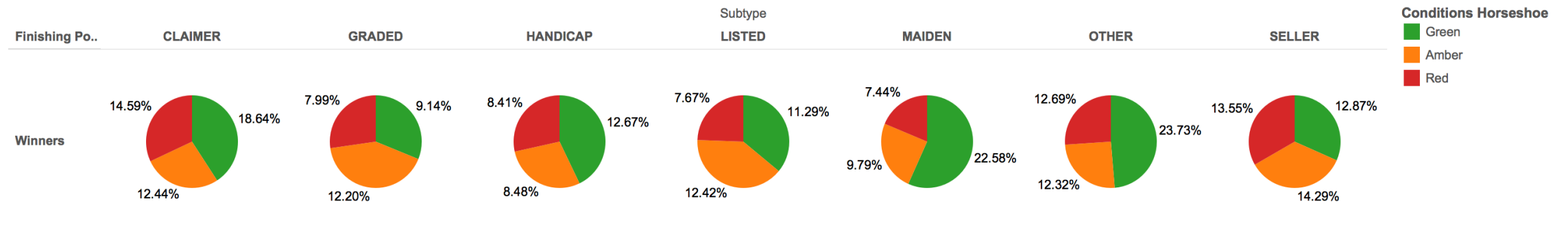


... red horseshoes should be avoided, but consider ambers, as they may be open to improvement and are often at decent odds.



# Conditions green and amber horseshoes should be of interest in all races...

Strike Rate By Conditions Horseshoe Colour

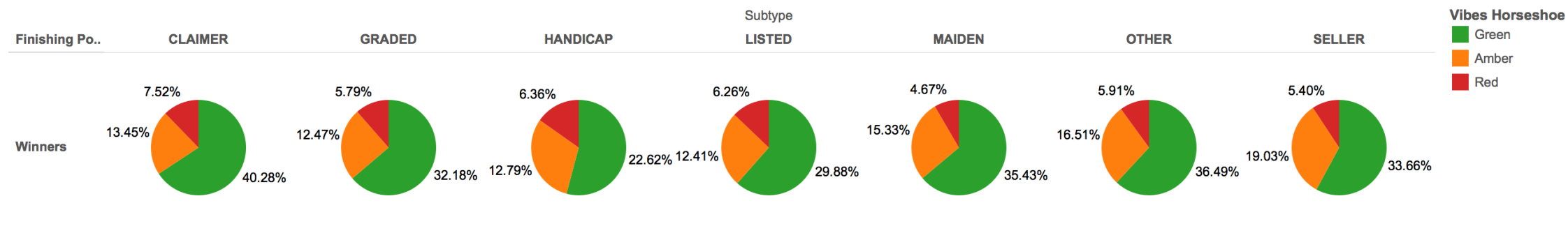


... red horseshoes should be considered, especially in poorer quality races, such as claimers and sellers.



# Vibes green horseshoes should be of interest in all races...

Strike Rate By Vibes Horseshoe Colour

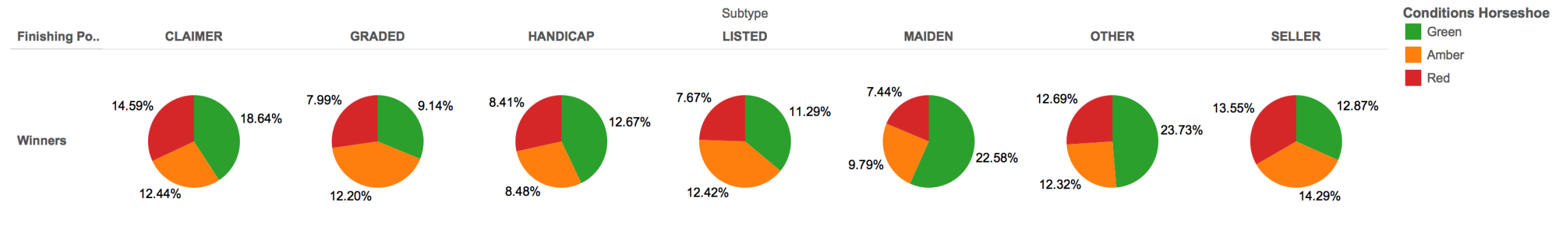


... red horseshoes should be avoided, and amber horseshoes considered in most races, as they may offer better value prices.

Strike Rate By Conditions Horseshoe Colour



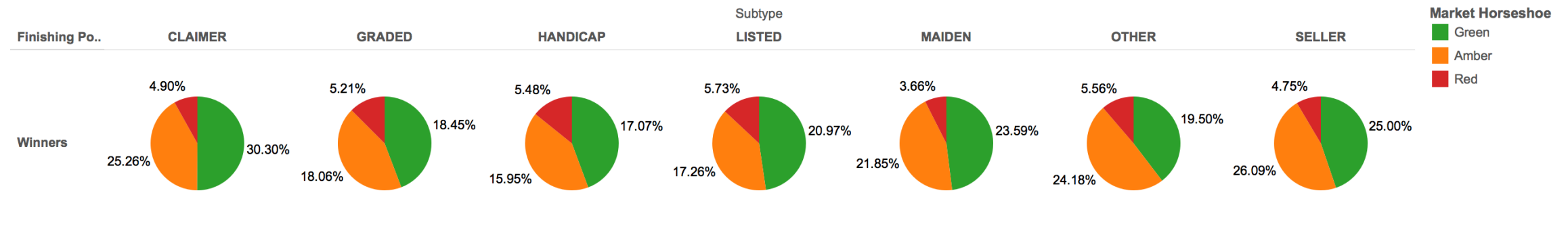
... red horseshoes should be considered, especially in poorer quality races, such as claimers and sellers.
