

Information on customer complaints against Sector Capital AS

Sector Capital AS (organisation number: 813 391 082, "the Company") is regulated by the Norwegian FSA (Finanstilsynet), and holds the following licenses:

Investment services and activities, Securities Trading Act § 2-1 (1):

- No 1: Reception and transmission of orders
- No 2: Execution of orders
- No 5: Investment advice
- No 7: Placing of financial instruments without a firm commitment basis

Ancillary services, Securities Trading Act § 2-1 (2):

- No 1: Safekeeping and administration of financial instruments
- No 2: Granting credits or loans
- No 3: Advice on capital structure, strategy et al.; advice and services re. to mergers and purchases

The right to set forth a complaint against the Company is described in the Securities Trading Regulations § 9-13. To ensure a swift process on the Company's side, the complainant should make sure the following information is sent to the Company:

- A formal complaint should be sent in writing to the Company.
 Either by e-mail: info@sector.no
 or in a letter to: Sector Capital AS, P.O. Box 462 Sentrum, 0105 Oslo, Norway.
- 2. The complaint should explicitly express that the Company has not fulfilled its duties as agreed, or made an error that have had implications for the client/investor. Sector Capital AS can only respond to inquiries relating to the Company. The complaint should point out:
 - > Who the complainant is: full name and tax id number / fund holder id.
 - > The grounds for the complaint: description of incident, stating the Company's error or neglect as perceived by the client/investor. The complaint should include name, date and time of any contact with Sector Capital AS employees.

The complainant shall, within 2 business days upon Sector Capital's receipt, receive a written confirmation that the complaint has been received. The complainant shall be duly informed should the company need further time to respond to the complaint.

A written response shall, without unfounded delay, be provided once the Company has considered and decided on the result of the complaint.
