

## **How can you recognise a Tudor House?**

Houses had wooden frames.

Small sticks and wet clay were put over them.

This is called wattle and daub.

## **What is wattle and daub?**

Wattle is the sticks.

Daub is a mix of clay, sand and animal dung.

Look at the picture to see this.

## **How to spot a real Tudor House.**

To spot a real Tudor house, look for wonky wood beams.

These beams were cut by hand.

The top floors on some Tudor homes were bigger than the bottom floor.

The top floor would overhang – this is called a jetty.
