TWo Seamen of the *Royal Charles* put on shore the last night by a *Catch* at *Harwich*, came hither this afternoon, who tell us, That in the Engagement on Friday and Saturday, we both days had the Enemy in chase, and had certainly given a very good account of them; but that on Saturday in the Evening they were re-inforced with the Success of 16 fresh Ships, but on Sunday our Fleet began to stand over towards our own Coasts, finding themselves too much over-peopled in numbers, and tired out with continual service, and their tackle much worn; but more especially hoping for the arrival of the Prince, whose approach, His Grace, the Lord General, was informed by a Packet, dispatched by him from *Harwich*, by the

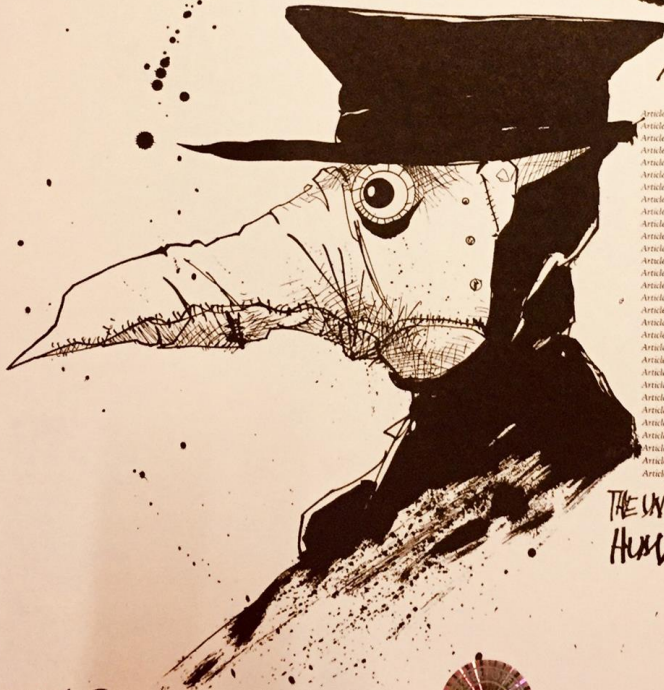
for *Portsmouth*, we are just now informed of the arrival of a Vessel of 100 Tons, and eight Guns belonging to *Plymouth* bound for *Bristol*. She formerly carried out from *Plymouth* to *Tangier*, thirty soldiers with Provisions; in her she met with an *Holland* Man of War of 24 Guns, she fought very bravely, and at last brought by the *London* had not Men enough to board her; she received many dred shot, but no hurt save only in her Rigging and Sails.

Falmouth, May 30. The 16 instant, 14 or 16 Gallies discovered off of *Fowey*, the Country people suspecting them to be Enemies, took some little alarm for their own security, but it presently passed over.

Plymouth, June 1. A private Man of War belonging to *London*, took out of the *Mersey* a small privateer
