

Dear parents,

Our residential trip is quickly approaching and we are all very excited! All information has now been passed onto Frank Chapman so that they are ready for our arrival.

We can now confirm that the members of staff accompanying the children on this trip will be myself, Mrs Whitehurst, Mr Phillips and Mrs Hadden.

The weather is looking nice for next week at the moment with some rain on our last day. Please make sure that your children have the appropriate clothing packed for this weather including a waterproof coat. If you need another copy of the kit list, I am happy to provide one for you.

On Wednesday, please bring your child/children to school at normal time, 8:45am. Cases can be dropped to hall from 8:40am. Children will also need to come to the hall on this day.

Here, Mrs Hadden will be awaiting any medication that has been indicated on the completed forms. All medication will need to be clearly labelled (name and dosage- including times it should be given). This includes any over the counter medication and medication that the children already have forms for in school, such as inhalers or Piriton. We ask that all parents complete a new form for all medication for this trip. Mrs Hadden will have these available to you.

Mrs Whitehurst will be collecting all spending money, again this needs to be clearly labelled with their name and in a purse/wallet. We ask that you send no more than £5, please give this in coins rather than a five-pound note to make this easier for the staff at Frank Chapman

Once you have dropped your child off, we welcome you to stay until we depart in the hall. Chairs will be laid out for you until the coach arrives. It will be greatly appreciated if you could help us take the cases up to the coach.

Please make sure that children bring 1 packed lunch with them for Wednesday lunch time. This needs to be in a plastic bag and labelled with their names so that all rubbish can be thrown away easily. Children will not need to bring any additional snacks with them. All food is provided by the centre and any food in their cases or bags will be confiscated until we return back to school as no food is permitted in the dorms.

As mentioned at the meeting last week, no electronics are allowed to be brought with the children, including mobile phones and tablets. These will also be confiscated until we return back to school. We will keep you updated on what the children are up to throughout the trip so you can hear about all they are getting up to.

On Friday, we will return to school after we have eaten lunch. We will leave Frank Chapman at 1pm in hope to be back at school for 2pm when you can come and collect your child.
