	<p>TRAINING DAY – NO LESSONS</p>	<p>Happy New Year! Today we will begin a new text and theme for English – Victorians. I would like you to look at the slides and read one or two of those that interest you. From each slide you read, I would like you to pick out some words that you have never seen before or do not understand. Make a note of them and find out what they mean using a dictionary. If you have a paper dictionary I would prefer you to use that as it will develop your skills more than using an online dictionary. Make your own glossary of the words you chose.</p>	<p>You will be using the slides from yesterday again today. I have provided you with a true or false sheet. It has lots of statements on it and you have to use the text in the slides to decide if the statement is true or false. Then write in the evidence you have found for it. This might mean copying out the key sentence which tells you directly or explaining what the inference tells you.</p>	<p>Look at the true statements from yesterday, Which of them impacted on you most? Why? If you were living in the Victorian times, what would you like and dislike about the facts. Make a mind map to show your thoughts. Use one colour to show the things you like about this era and another colour to show the things you do not like about this era.</p>	<p>COLD WRITE: Imagine you are a child in the Victorian times. You are looking for a job to help your family bring money home to feed the family. A job comes up as a chimney sweep and you think of applying for it. Write a letter explaining that you would like the job and why you would be good at it.</p>
