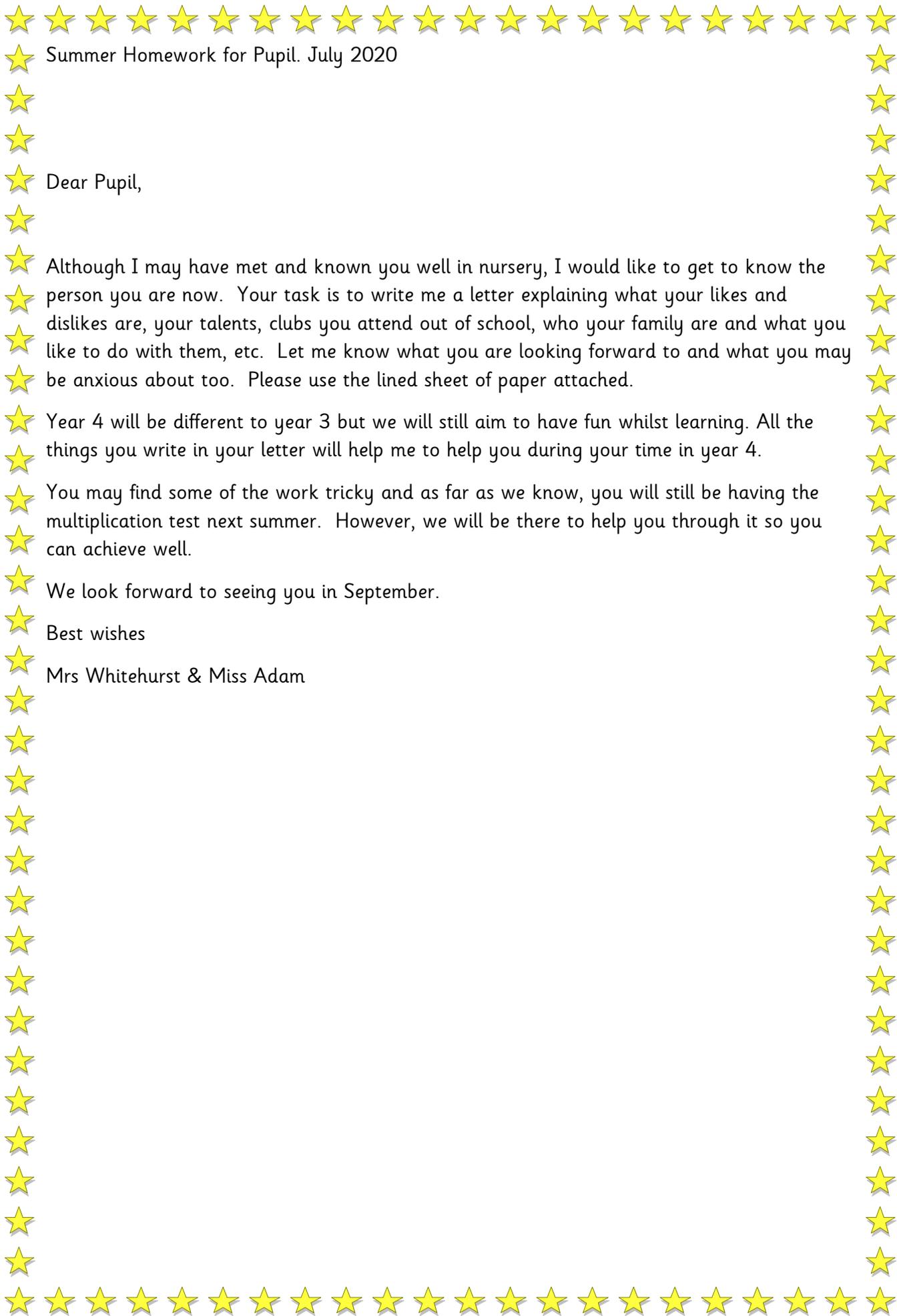

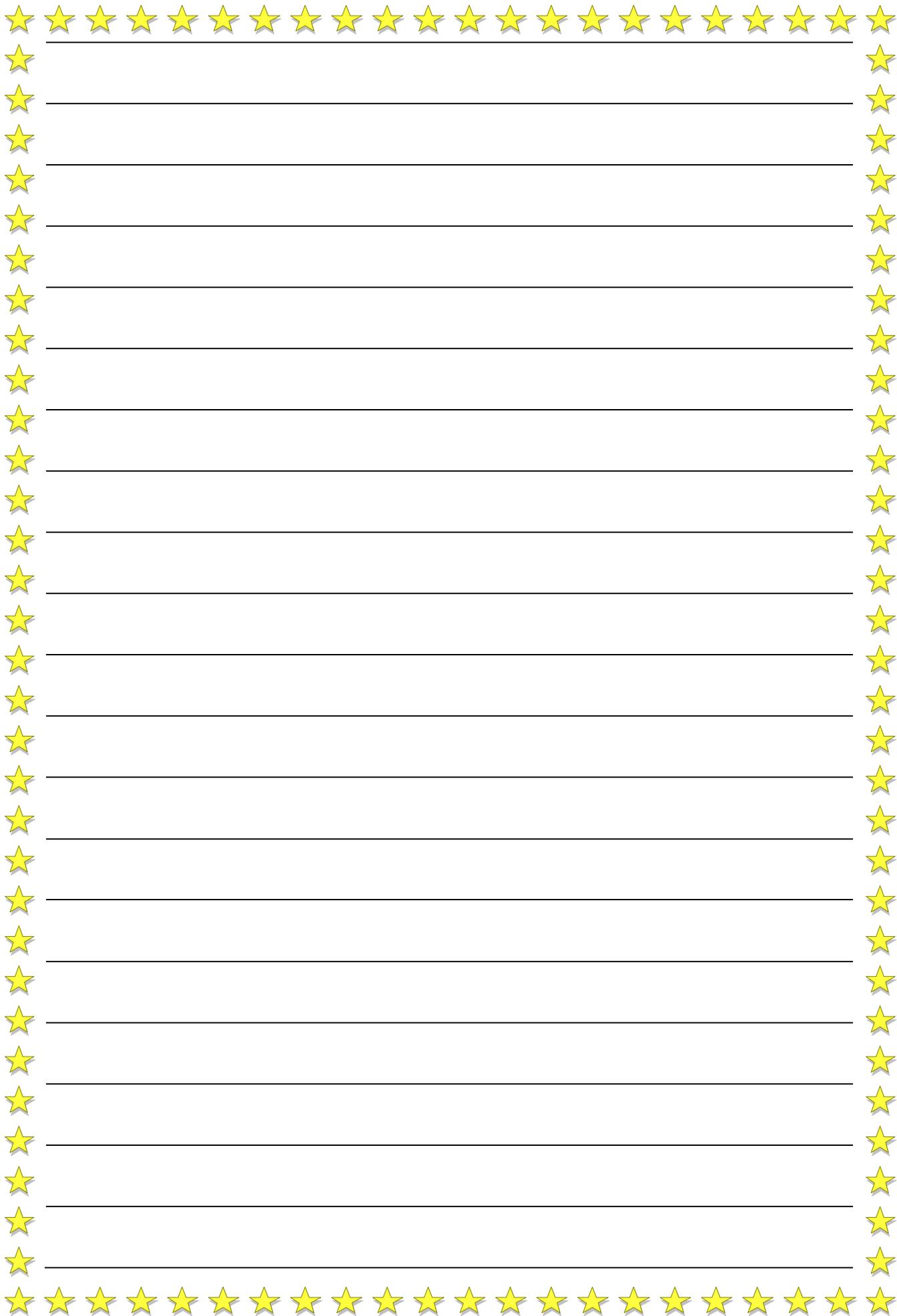
★ Year 4 will be different to year 3 but we will still aim to have fun whilst learning. All the things you write in your letter will help me to help you during your time in year 4.
