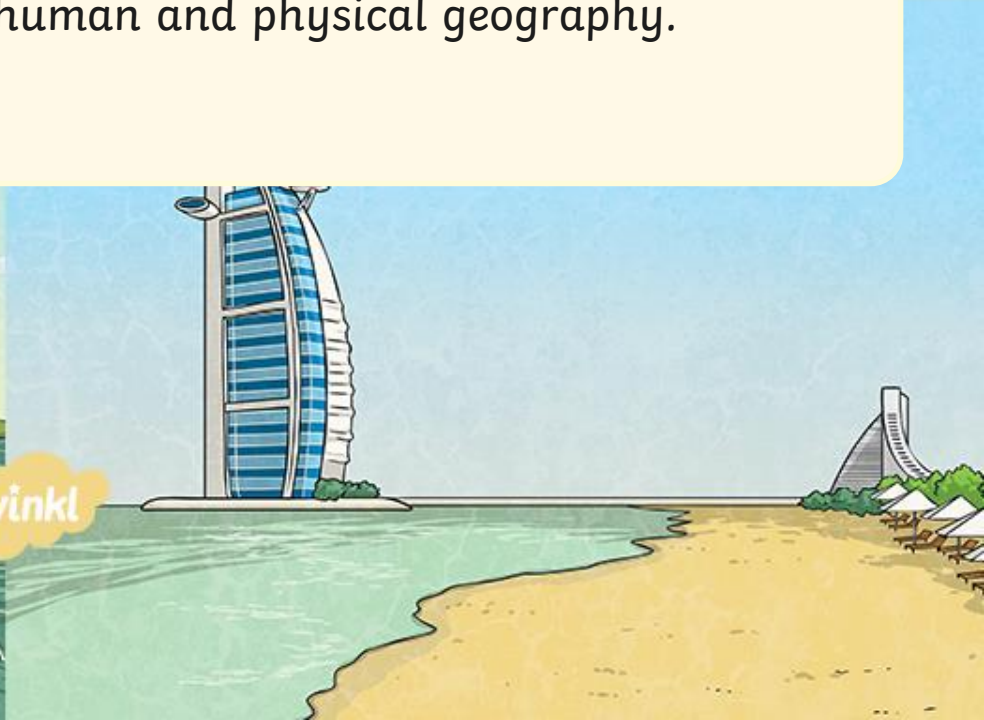


# Comparing Places in Europe!

# Human and Physical Geography

## Human Geography

Human geography relates to human activity or something that is humanly-constructed.

It studies the interaction between human activity and the planet.

Human geography might look at:

- Economy
- Energy resources
- Trade
- Population



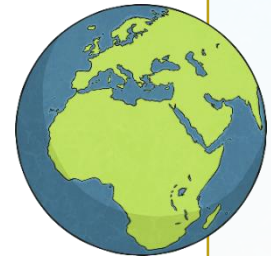
## Physical Geography

Physical geography relates to geography that is naturally occurring.

It studies the natural environment and landscapes of our planet.

Physical geography might look at:

- The weather
- Mountains
- Rivers
- Volcanoes
- Earthquakes
- Biomes (Places with similar animals, plants, landscapes and weather)

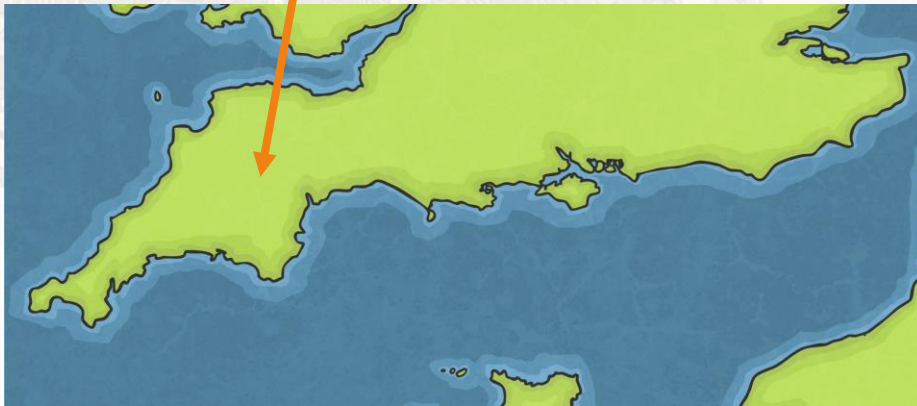

These places are in different parts of the Europe. They have many similarities and many differences.

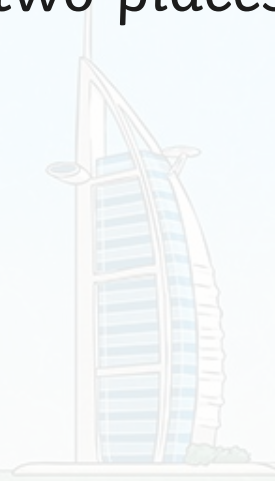
Look at these two images. What is similar and what is different?
